



Nursery Guidelines

Children showing any visible signs of illness are not allowed into the nursery or classroom

- Fever (a child should be free of fever for 24 hours before entering)
- Vomiting or diarrhea (even associated with teething and medication)
- Any symptoms of childhood diseases such as chicken pox, cough, strep throat, flue, etc. or any other infectious or contagious disease
- Cloudy or green runny noses or persistent cough
- Common cold from onset through one week
- Sore throat
- Fifth Disease (distinctive red rash on the face or body)
- Any unexplained rash
- Pink eye or other eye infections (All eye infections are contagious. The child must be on medication for 24 hours and not exhibiting any symptoms before entering)
- Any communicable diseases
